



SUMMARY STATEMENT:

Sunset Lake Park was purchased through an agreement with the Texas General Land Office in 1999. The park includes approximately 245 acres of high quality coastal wetlands. Funding for the purchase required that the City grant a perpetual Conservation Easement encompassing the entire park.

To facilitate the easement, Ordinance No. 1002 was passed in February of 2000 and included a list of rules governing activities and behaviors at Sunset Park. Among other things, the easement requires the City to “protect the natural resources...” of the park. We interpret natural resources as indigenous plants and wildlife.

In recent years, however, a series of events involving colonies of domestic and/or feral cats (a non-indigenous species) has highlighted the need for an unambiguous rule that prohibits park users from feeding animals in the park.

The City has a duty under the Sunset Lake Park Conservation Easement to preserve the natural resources in the park. This amendment is necessary to continue to meet that duty.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Approve the second and final reading of Ordinance No. 2042 amending Section 14-63 of the Code of Ordinances.

ORDINANCE NO. 2042

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE V, SECTION 14-63, SUBSECTION 8, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES SPECIFIC RULES IN SUNSET LAKE PARK; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, PROVIDING FOR PENALTY FOR VIOLATION, AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS Ordinance No. 1002 was adopted in February of 2000 and included a list of park rules governing activities and behaviors at Sunset Lake Park, and;

WHEREAS to continue to protect the natural resources, a change in the rules is necessary;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PORTLAND, TEXAS, AS FOLLOWS TO-WIT:

SECTION 1-AMENDMENTS: Article V, Section 14-63, Subsection (8) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Portland is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 14-63. Park rules.

The following rules are hereby adopted for Sunset Lake Park:

- (1) No motorized boats of any kind shall be allowed on Sunset Lake except those required by government or law enforcement agencies for official use.
- (2) All-terrain vehicles, motorized dirt bikes of any kind, go carts and other similar vehicles shall be prohibited within park boundaries.
- (3) Parking on the park road (connector) outside designated parking areas shall be prohibited.
- (4) Boating, fishing, swimming and related activities shall be prohibited on interior ponds between the park road (connector) and Corpus Christi Bay.
- (5) Open fires not authorized by the city for special events and inspected by the fire marshal shall be prohibited.
- (6) The disposal of litter, material, liquids or any other possible pollutant within park boundaries shall be prohibited.
- (7) Guns of any kind, bows and sling-shots shall be prohibited within park boundaries except when used by law enforcement officers to carry out their official duties.

- (8) ~~Willful acts that seriously threaten or endanger birds and animals shall be prohibited.~~
No person shall intentionally feed, harass, kill or release any animal or bird within the park boundaries.
- (9) Concessions not authorized by the city shall be prohibited.

The Parks and Recreation Director may, with the approval of the City Manager, establish and enforce other rules deemed necessary to protect natural resources, preserve park improvements or promote public safety. Such rules must be visibly posted to establish warning and be enforced.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY: If any provision, section, clause or phrase of this Ordinance, or the application of same to any person or set of circumstances is, for any reason held to be unconstitutional, void or invalid, the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby, it being the intent of the City Council in adopting this Ordinance that no portion hereof, or provisions or regulations contained herein, shall become inoperative or fail by reason of any other portion hereof, and all provisions of this Ordinance are declared severable for that purpose.

SECTION 3. VIOLATION AND PENALTY: Any person who violates this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be subject to a fine not exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500). Each and every day that a violation of this Ordinance occurs shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 4. PUBLICATION: This Ordinance shall be published after second reading hereof by publishing the caption thereof in the official newspaper with a statement the public may view the Ordinance in the Office of the City Secretary. This Ordinance shall be effective from and after the publication provided herein.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its final reading and the publication of its caption in the official newspaper of record.

SUMMARY STATEMENT: The Parks and Recreation Advisory Board was created by Ordinance 179 in 1963 with the mission of assisting city council and staff in the assessment of open space, park, recreation and athletic needs in the city. In recent years it has become increasingly difficult to recruit members and maintain a consistent quorum.

Ordinance No. 2043 reduces the number of members in the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board from nine (9) to seven (7). The reduction in members will allow for greater retention and increased participation.

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt a motion that approves the second (final) reading of Ordinance No 2043 which reduces the number of Park and Recreation Advisory Board members from 9 to 7.

WHEREAS the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board was created by Ordinance No. 179 in 1963; and,

WHEREAS the Code of Ordinances Article II, Section 14-17 states that there will be nine members; and,

WHEREAS similar boards with similar size work plans have fewer board members; and,

WHEREAS the Mayor and City Council believe that the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board can fulfill its duties effectively and more efficiently with fewer board members;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PORTLAND, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: Article II, Section 14-17 of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

There is hereby created by the city a parks and recreation advisory board which shall be composed of ~~nine (9)~~ seven (7) members appointed by the city council. All members shall be residents of the city and known to be interested in public parks and recreation.

SECTION 2. REPEALER: All previously adopted rules, regulations, policies and ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY: If any provision, section, clause or phrase of this Ordinance, or the application of same to any person or set of circumstances is, for any reason held to be unconstitutional, void or invalid, the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby, it being the intent of the City Council in adopting this Ordinance that no portion hereof, or provisions or regulations contained herein, shall become inoperative or fail by reason of any other portion hereof, and all provisions of this Ordinance are declared severable for that purpose.

SECTION 4. PUBLICATION: This Ordinance shall be published after second reading hereof by publishing the caption thereof in the official newspaper with a statement the public may view the Ordinance in the Office of the City Secretary. This Ordinance shall be effective from and after the publication provided herein.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its final reading and the publication of its caption in the official newspaper of record.

SUMMARY STATEMENT: The Senior Citizen Advisory Board was created in 2007 with the mission of assisting city council and staff in the assessment of senior citizen needs throughout the community. In recent years it has become increasingly difficult to recruit members and maintain a consistent quorum.

Ordinance No. 2044 reduces the number of members in the Senior Citizen Advisory Board from seven (7) to five (5). The reduction in members will allow for greater retention and increased participation.

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt a motion that approves the second (final) reading of Ordinance No. 2044 which reduces the number of Senior Advisory Board members from 7 to 5.

WHEREAS the Senior Services Advisory Board was created by Ordinance No. 1165 in 2007; and,

WHEREAS the Code of Ordinances Article VII, Section 14-73 states that there will be seven members; and,

WHEREAS the Mayor and City Council believe that the Senior Services Advisory Board can fulfill its duties effectively and more efficiently with fewer board members; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PORTLAND, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: Article VII, Section 14-73 of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

There is hereby created a senior services advisory board. It shall be comprised of ~~seven~~ (7) five (5) members, all of whom are appointed by the city council. All members of the board shall be qualified Portland voters.

SECTION 2. REPEALER: All previously adopted rules, regulations, policies and ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY: If any provision, section, clause or phrase of this Ordinance, or the application of same to any person or set of circumstances is, for any reason held to be unconstitutional, void or invalid, the validity of the remaining portions of this

Ordinance shall not be affected thereby, it being the intent of the City Council in adopting this Ordinance that no portion hereof, or provisions or regulations contained herein, shall become inoperative or fail by reason of any other portion hereof, and all provisions of this Ordinance are declared severable for that purpose.

SECTION 4. PUBLICATION: This Ordinance shall be published after second reading hereof by publishing the caption thereof in the official newspaper with a statement the public may view the Ordinance in the Office of the City Secretary. This Ordinance shall be effective from and after the publication provided herein.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its final reading and the publication of its caption in the official newspaper of record.






