Fences that were damaged by Hurricane Harvey can be replaced with no permit fee if the following requirements are met:

- Fences must be replaced in the location as originally constructed.
- Fences may be maximum of 8 feet in height.
- Fences must be constructed of wood, masonry, wrought iron, or vinyl or similar materials. Chain link, barbed wire, razor wire, woven wire, chicken or hog wire, stockade panels, sheet metal, and corrugated metals are prohibited.
- Fences and gates used as barriers for swimming pools and spas must comply with 2015 International Swimming Pool and Spa Code.
- Contractors must be registered with the City of Portland prior to commencement of work. Requirements for contractors hauling off construction debris is waived. Construction debris may be placed for curbside debris removal.

*I, the applicant for this permit, warrant the truthfulness of all the information provided in this application and understand that if any of the information provided is incorrect, the permit may be revoked by the Development Services Department. I certify that all work will be in full conformity with the City of Portland ordinances and applicable state laws.*
